



HOW TO: CREATE A MORE SUSTAINABLE WORKING ENVIRONMENT.

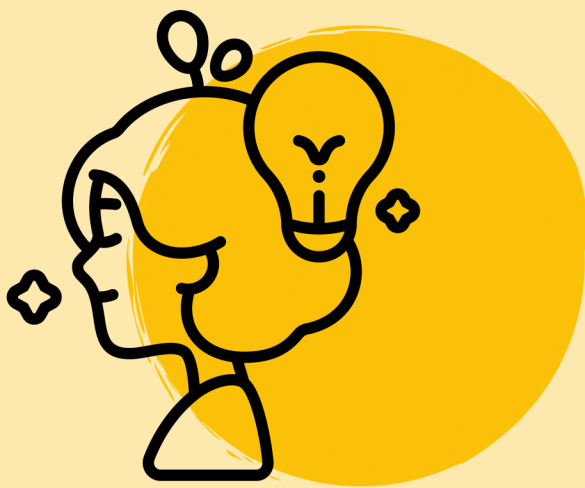


1. CYCLE TO WORK SCHEME

Banning holiday communications is a wonderful way for companies to give their staff a real rest from the office.

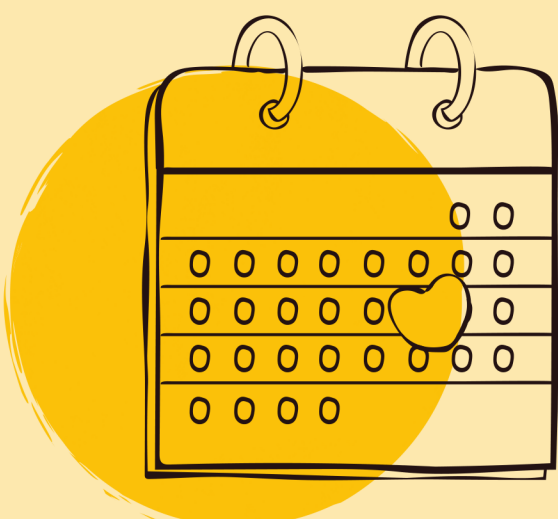


3. USE REUSABLE CUPS AND BOTTLES
